**CDFG Healthy Soils Program** invests in the development of healthy soils on California's farm and ranch lands by supporting practices that promote soil health improvement practices, such as cover cropping, compost application and installing native vegetation.

**Central Valley Habitat Exchange** creates market-based opportunities for farmers, ranchers, and landowners to receive compensation for effective habitat restoration and conservation in the Central Valley.

**Fish Food on Floodplains** mimics natural floodplain productivity by inundating farm fields in winter, in order to re-integrate the flow of floodplain food resources and nutrients back to the river system.
